

View logs with QXmlEdit


Using QXmlEdit to highlight the information.



One of the new features of QXmlEdit is the use of custom styles to change the appearance of the elements.


To use this feature you need to create a style file as shown in the manual, then you have to install it.

Install the style




A - Open the preferences

Use the menu item Edit > Configure to activate the preferences.



B - Find the folder


In the preference panel
1- Activate the "style" panel
2- Open the styles folder using the "Open Location in the Browser" button.



C - Install the style


Drag the style file into the folder and restart QXmlEdit.

Use the new mode




1 Open a file

Open a xml file



2 Select the new style

To apply the style click on the style tool button and select the new style



3 View the data

Look at the relevant information highlighted by the style.
In this XSD sample, it is possible to view at a glance the elements that reference another one and the attributes of type string.
